The General Services Administration (GSA) Schedules program creates long-term government-wide contracts with commercial firms to provide federal, state, local and other government customers with access to millions of commercial products and services at volume discount pricing.

As a GSA contract holder, IST can offer its eligible government customers access to streamlined purchasing via pre-negotiated, discounted pricing and standardized contract terms and conditions. Because we've established these contracts directly with the government, you can be assured that our pricing meets the "fair and reasonable" standard – an important distinction. IST has worked to ensure that our product offerings match state-of-the-art, real-world requirements, and that our labor designations match commercial labor categories – all with special discounts for government purchasers.

Additionally, IST partners with other GSA schedule holders like Bosch, ComNet, Genetec and other highly respected manufacturers to provide our customers with complete systems.

Who Can Use GSA Contracts?

- ◆ All federal agencies and activities in the executive, legislative and judicial branches.
- ◆ Government contractors authorized in writing by a federal agency pursuant to 48 CFR 51.1.
- ◆ Mixed ownership government corporations (as defined in the Government Corporation Control Act of 1945, as amended).
- ◆ The government of the District of Columbia.
- ◆ Other activities and organizations authorized by statute or regulation to use GSA as a source of supply
- ◆ State and local governments may use GSA Schedules under the Cooperative Purchasing Agreement established under Schedule 70 and 84.
